## 2022-23 INTRODUCTORY NEWSLETTER

Welcome to Artistic Dance Unlimited!

In this letter, you will find reminders and information useful to parents and students to get this dance year started. It is imperative that ALL the information is read and understood by parents and their dancers. As always, we look forward to providing our students with quality dance instruction.

### **Covid 19 update:**

At Artistic Dance Unlimited, we have always maintained the cleanest possible environment. We are doing the same things we have always done to prevent flu, colds, and viruses from spreading. The studio is cleaned by a professional cleaning company and uses the industries top cleaning agents and sanitizers. We are using the highest rating of MERV air filters to have the best air quality possibly. We have obtained a sanitizing agent that is on the EPA approved list for use against COVID-19. This agent will be used on ALL surfaces at the studio (including floor) daily. We have also purchased true HEPA Filter Air purifiers for all dance rooms.

We do ask that if your child is sick or has any sign of fever that you keep them home and not send them to the studio until they have been fever free for at least 24 hours. Please limit the number of parents and siblings in the lobby, utilize the front lobby space only, and keep the round tables for dancers use for eating and homework.

### **Monthly Newsletters:**

At ADU, we feel things run smoothly when everyone is informed. For this reason, we provide monthly newsletters to keep parents up to date on upcoming events, studio holidays, and fee schedules. Newsletters are available at the first of each month and are sent via e-mail and posted on our website [adudance.com](http://adudance.com). If you do not have access to e-mail, then you must see the office for a paper copy.

Many of your questions can be answered by reading the newsletter. Please be sure you have our email saved in your contact list, sometimes our emails will get filtered out as spam.

### **Office Information:**

As always, we strive to ensure that the business side of ADU runs smoothly. For your convenience, our office hours are Monday through Thursday 3:00-7:00pm. Jennifer Walker will be in the office Monday/Wednesday and Sharon Reeder will be in the office Tuesday/Thursday to receive tuition payments, collect fees, and to answer questions. We are so glad to have Jennifer & Sharon back to keep things running smoothly.

If you need to talk directly to your child's instructor, you are encouraged to leave a message in the office or send an email and the teacher will get back with you as soon as possible. **Please be considerate of your instructor's personal time and refrain from contacting them outside of studio business hours.** If you need further assistance, Directors Alette Garner and Ursula Margolis are available via email or by appointment.

## **TUITION AND FEES**

**Tuition may be placed in the tuition box in the lobby, paid at the office window, or online. Please always get a receipt for cash payments. Always write your dancer's name on the memo line of the check so that the money is credited to the proper account.**

- Tuition is due on the first day of each month. All tuition must be paid by the 10th of the month.
- Tuition received after the 10th of the month will have a \$10.00 late fee added to the student's account.
- A \$25.00 service charge will be issued for checks returned due to Non-Sufficient Funds.
- Tuition is due regardless of number of classes missed by the student.
- Tuition is based on a yearly fee that is divided into monthly payments. Some months will have more classes than others due to calendar fluctuations. The same amount of tuition is due each month regardless of the number of lessons.
- Any accounts more than 90 days past due will result in your dancer being dismissed from classes until your account is paid in full.
- Tuition can be paid by cash, check, or credit/debit card (Visa, MasterCard & Discover). There is a convenience fee of 3.75% for using a credit/debit card. This applies if you pay online or in person.

### **\*\*DROPPING ENROLLMENT POLICY\***

If a student wishes to drop enrollment in any/or all classes, a written/email notice of withdrawal must be given prior to the first day of the following month. We must have written notice by the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month if a dancer is withdrawing from class. If notice is given after the first day of the month, then tuition is due until formal notice has been received in the office.

### **Costume Deposits:**

Two deposit installments will be made before costumes are ordered. \$30 per class costume

**Costume Deposit #1 is due by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

**Costume Deposit #2 is due by November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

- **Costume deposits are non-refundable, and costumes will not be ordered until both deposits have been made.**
- **The balance on all costumes will be due February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.**
- **Students will not receive their costumes until the balance has been paid and tuition is up to date.**
- **Anyone not participating in the recital must give written notice by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 in order to avoid final costume fees.**

### **Recital Fee:**

This fee will run approximately from \$65-\$75 per student. This fee is used for Recital production expenses for the venue, lighting and sound production fee, trophies for students, and 1 USB of the recital shows per family.

\*\*\*Reminders of all fees and due dates will be in the monthly newsletter and on the calendar in the lobby

### **Lobby & Common Areas:**

We ask that parents utilize the front lobby area to wait on their dancers. Please leave the round tables free for our dancers to use for eating and doing homework during their break times. The round table common area is reserved for our dancers use only. Please reserve lobby space for parents of dancers age 7 and under.

## **General Studio Rules:**

We ask that for the safety of the children that all students and parents adhere to these rules. We ask the parents to help enforce the rules when possible. The rules are as follows:

- **NO RUNNING IN THE STUDIO. THIS INCLUDES STUDENTS AND SIBLINGS!**
- **STUDENTS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE STUDIO ROOMS UNTIL DIRECTED BY THE INSTRUCTOR**
- **NON-STUDENTS ARE NEVER ALLOWED IN THE STUDIOS EXCEPT DURING SPECIFIED OBSERVATION TIMES**
- **STUDENTS MAY NOT HANG ON THE BALLET BARRES**
- **NO CHEWING GUM**
- **FOOD OR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED IN THE SNACK AREA ONLY**
- **PROPER DRESS IS REQUIRED FOR CLASS**
- **STUDENTS SHOULD NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN LOBBY**
- **SIBLINGS OF STUDENTS MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES AND NEED TO ADHERE TO THE STUDIO RULES..**
- **NO BULLYING OR PROFANITY**
- **PARENTS OBSERVATION ALLOWED ONLY ON SPECIFIED DAYS OR AT TEACHER'S DISCRETION**
- **NO TOUCHING OR BANGING ON THE MIRRORS**
- **DO NOT TOUCH OR PLAY WITH THE STEREO EQUIPMENT**
- **NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN OFFICE**
- **NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN PRIVATE OFFICE WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF ALETTE OR URSULA**
- **STUDENTS MUST WAIT INSIDE BUILDING UNTIL THEIR PARENT/RIDE IS PRESENT IN PARKING LOT**

### **Careful in Parking Lot**

Please be careful when exiting the parking lot. We have two exits- one onto Gill Street at back of parking lot and one onto Avenue B. Please be aware of their locations to avoid driving off the curb.

**PLEASE** enter and exit the parking lot slowly and carefully. **Please come in and get dancers under the age of 8yrs old, and please remind your dancers to wait inside the lobby for you.**

We are surrounded by growing businesses and the parking lot is getting a lot busier.

## **PARENT OBSERVATION:**

There will be two parent observations held throughout the year. The first one will be before Christmas break, December 12<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> 2022. The second will be in the Spring when the costumes are ready to be handed out, April 10<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The studio room doors will be kept closed on a regular basis as an open door causes many distractions (especially for young dancers). Closed circuit cameras in all studios will allow parents to observe classes on the TV screen in the lobby. This is a wonderful way to keep track of your child's progress in class. We ask that parents use discretion when viewing their child's class. If your child is not behaving appropriately, we ask that you let the instructor handle the situation in class. Please **DO NOT DISTURB** a class while it is in progress. When necessary, the instructor will inform you of any problems that occur in class.

## **ATTENDANCE POLICY:**

Attending classes regularly is necessary for dancers to progress their dancing ability. Excessive absences interrupt the learning process. Tuition is due regardless of number of classes a student misses. There will be NO make-up classes or refunds offered for classes missed by student. In the event a class is cancelled due to inclement weather or absence of instructor, a make-up lesson will be offered. Thank you for making every effort to have your children in class each week.

## **INCLEMENT WEATHER:**

In the case of inclement weather, please call the studio. We will leave a message regarding closing by 2:00pm. Notification emails will be sent, and the information will be posted on Facebook and Instagram. The studio may not necessarily close when the school systems close if the weather has shown improvement throughout the day. Any classes missed for inclement weather will be made up in the spring months.

## **DRESS CODE:**

**THE DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. STUDENTS WHO DO NOT ADHERE TO ALL ASPECTS OF ADU'S DRESS CODE MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE CLASS.**

- Students may wear any color or style of dance clothes (leotard, tights, jazz pants, leggings)
- Students must wear proper dance clothes to class! NO t-shirts, shorts, or baggy street clothes are accepted.
- Pink tights are REQUIRED for all female Junior level and above Ballet classes.
- All female students should wear tights/leggings for all classes.
- Students must have their hair pulled up and away from their face in a neat and secure style (i.e., ponytail or bun.) If hair is long enough for a ponytail, then it must be in one. If ponytail is long and distracts the student while dancing, then it must be secured in a bun.
- Male students may wear exercise attire which includes elastic waist shorts or sweats. Please wear t-shirts that fit and are not too baggy.

## **CLASS SHOE REQUIREMENTS:**

**Students must have the appropriate color shoes by April 2023 which is prior to Picture Day.**

\*Please note that ballet and jazz shoes should fit feet like a glove. Leather shoes will stretch 1/2 a size. For your online ordering convenience, we have try on sizes of ballet, jazz & tap shoes available in the office.

### **BALLET (ALL AGES)**

Pink split sole or full sole leather ballet shoes. Capezio is the recommended brand.

### **JAZZ (ALL AGES)**

Capezio slip on jazz shoes. Caramel color style # EJ2 (adult) #EJ2C(child) Teen, Intermediate, and Senior level classes may possibly need black jazz shoes to match their costumes.

### **TAP (Ages 3, 4/5, 6/7, Junior 1/2/3)**

Capezio Mary Jane tap shoe. Caramel color. Style #3800(adult) #3800C(child)

### **TAP (Intermediate & Senior)**

Capezio black leather lace up split sole or full sole tap shoes.

### **LYRICAL & CONTEMPORARY (Junior 1/2/3, Teen, Intermediate & Senior)**

Canvas skin tone Turners

### **ACRO (All ages & levels)**

No shoes required. Bare feet only for class.

### **HIPHOP (Pre hip-hop, Junior 1/2/3, Teen, Intermediate & Senior)**

Any full heel sneaker, everyday lace up sneaker, or dance sneaker. All hip-hop classes will be required to buy shoes that match their costume at a later date.

### **MALE STUDENTS (all ages/levels)**

Black ballet shoes, Black slip-on jazz shoes, Black lace up tap shoes

### **DANCE COMPANY (all levels)**

Shoes to be determined depending on costume choices.
